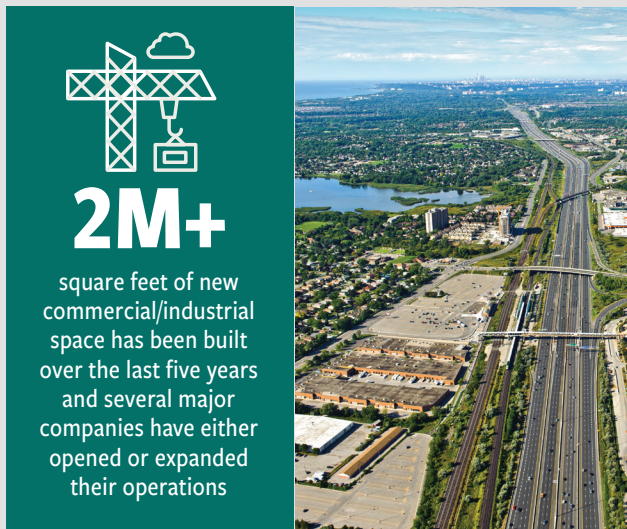


TRANSPORTATION AND LOGISTICS
